Dear Friends,

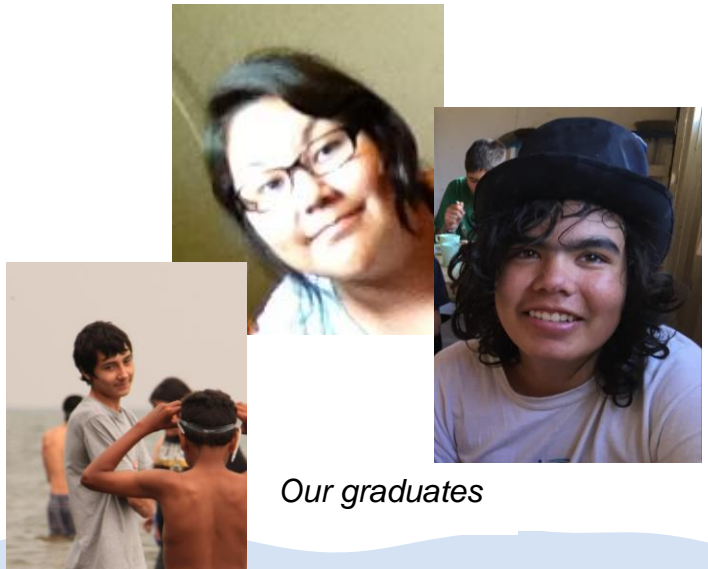
